

## Data protection and sharing of contact details with third parties

IAS takes data protection and privacy seriously. This statement explains why and how we process your personal data and seeks your consent. Data protection is warranted in accordance with the Swiss Federal Data Protection Act (FDPA), the German Tele Service Data Protection Act (TDPA) and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

IAS will collect, process, transfer and store applicant's personal data only for:

- enabling (non) commercial organizations to order exhibition space or satellite symposia through the IAS Satellites and Exhibition Tracker (ISET), for the preparation and execution of the 10<sup>th</sup> IAS Conference on HIV Science (IAS 2019).
- The preparation of future IAS and AIDS conferences.

Personal data we collect through the IAS Satellites and Exhibition Tracker (ISET) is limited to:

- full name, gender, email, phone, fax, organisation/affiliation/company details.

To reach the objectives listed above, full name and email address will be shared with the following third parties:

- the IAS 2019 Registration Department, c/o **K.I.T. Swiss S.A, Switzerland/Germany, Registration supplier**, in order to enable the Registration Department to execute the register process of day passes and/or exhibitor passes (for specific persons as invited by satellite organizers and exhibitors) for IAS 2019.
- **pharma service – a business unit of documediaS GmbH, Germany** – Abstract management provider.

IAS will nevertheless contractually ensure that your personal data will be processed by the above listed third parties to the same extent as it is authorized for itself under Swiss law and GDPR. The IAS will also ensure that all third parties which will process your personal data have implemented appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your personal data against accidental or unlawful destruction or accidental loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure or access, and which provide a level of security appropriate to the risk represented by the processing and the nature of the data to be protected. Your personal data is only kept as long as necessary for the fulfilment of the purposes. When your personal data is not necessary anymore, we will make sure to delete it.

In accordance with the different data protection laws that apply, you have a right of access, a right of rectification, a right of erasure, a right of limitation, a right of opposition of processing your personal data.

***The delegates herewith authorize the IAS to collect, process and transfer their personal data to the above listed third parties and authorities.*** The delegates further expressly acknowledge and agree that any personal data disclosed in connection with the conference profile and registration form will be subject to the laws of the country where it is transferred and may not be covered by Swiss law. IAS cannot assure delegates that the laws and regulations in the recipient country will necessarily offer the same level of confidentiality or data protection as under Swiss law or GDPR and may require the above listed third parties and/or authorities to whom the personal data is transferred, to disclose all or any part of the personal data to other authorities or third parties.
